GUIDANCE FOR VISITATION & ELECTION STIPENDS (updated December 2022)

Fraternities and groups provide a stipend <u>according to their means</u>, to the Visitors, for travel expenses in accordance with the *National Statutes* article 18:8.

In addition, the local fraternity arranges for overnight lodging if needed.

Please have the fraternity treasurer write one check made payable to "BSSF Region" for the travel expenses for the Pastoral Visitor and Fraternal Visitor and any additional contribution you might like to make to the Region to help defray overall expenses associated with visitations and elections.

<u>Note</u>: If a religious is the Pastoral Visitor, please write a separate check made payable to that Visitor for his/her travel expenses and any additional stipend you might like to contribute for their service.

We offer the following suggestions to compensate for travel expenses, based on mileage involved (round trip travel would be double the amount listed).

10 - 50 miles one-way: \$ 45.00 51 - 100 miles one-way: \$ 90.00 101 - 150 miles one-way: \$ 135.00 151 - 200 miles one-way: \$180.00

The travel expenses are for each Visitor. We try to schedule Visitors that are close in distance to the fraternities and groups so there is less mileage involved. Also, sometimes, visitors are able to travel together to reduce expenses involved.

If any of this is a hardship, perhaps you could send an offering in installments.
